

## ARTS WORKSHOPS

1. CLAY/WHEEL THROWING CLASSES with Kate and Shane Jarrett, Potters-in-Residence. Cost: \$5/student per one-hour workshop, includes firing. Classes can be arranged with a 10 student minimum.
2. APPLIED SCIENCE THROUGH CLAY with Kate and Shane Jarrett, Potters-in-Residence. This brings the practical understanding of science and the creative exploration of clay together for maximum learning. Includes two major projects: painting with natural pigments as well as applying pigments to a clay tile which will be fired, along with scientific explanations of chemical change. Cost: \$6.50/student, 10 students minimum.
3. THEATER TOUR & WORKSHOP. Tour the theater and take part in a workshop of your choice: theater games, improvisation skills, basic acting or stage movement. Cost: \$3/student per one-hour workshop. This package can be arranged with a 10 student minimum.
4. VISUAL ARTS WORKSHOPS in watercolor, color theory, landscape, still life, 3-D art. Cost: \$4/student per one-hour workshop. Workshop can be arranged with a 10 student minimum.
5. WEAVING/FIBER ARTS WORKSHOP includes instructor-based use of our looms and other weaving projects. Cost: \$4/student per one-hour workshop. Workshop can be arranged with a 10 student minimum.
6. PAINTING REENACTMENT. With costumes and props, instructor will guide students as they reenact one of the paintings in the Sangre de Cristo Arts Center collection. Cost: \$3/ student per one-hour workshop. Workshop can be arranged with a 10 student minimum.
7. WRITING IN THE GALLERIES WORKSHOP. Explore creative writing using works of art in the Sangre de Cristo Galleries. Cost: \$3/student per one-hour workshop. Workshop can be arranged with a 10 student minimum.
8. DANCE WORKSHOP includes dance (zumba, hip hop, or your choice) or creative movement class. Cost: \$3/student per one-hour workshop. Workshop can be arranged with a 10 student minimum.
9. SPECIAL REQUEST WORKSHOPS. Match a home school curriculum or specific topic. Qualified instructors/working artists can be found for a variety of age-appropriate workshops. Call with specific ideas and our education department can find an instructor for a special workshop. (Depending on supplies and teacher fee, costs range from \$3 to \$5 per student. Each workshop can be arranged for a 10 student minimum.)
