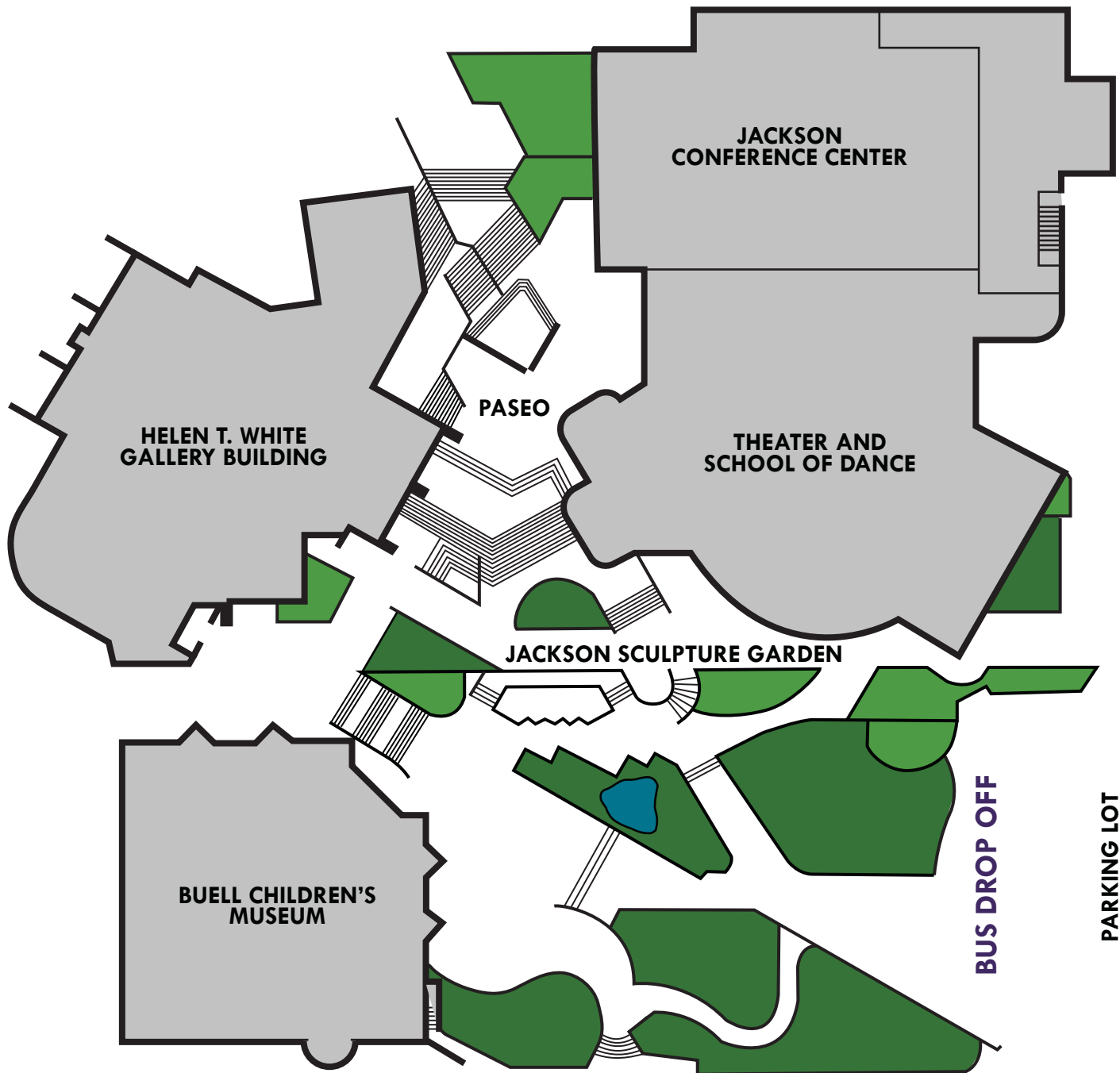

Exo-Sanctuaries: A Rough Ruby Collection

Mathias "Mo" Valdez: Things and Stuff

March 12, 2022 – August 7, 2022

Mathias Valdez founded Lastleaf Printing in Pueblo in 2009. He says about his work, "I do not want to introduce this body of art work as a personal reflection on what I believe or how I perceive the world. To try and render some insight or retrospect in an attempt to influence you to interpret my art as some grand philosophy or conclusion would be bogus - because the truth is that I do not have any of it figured out.

Liz McCombs: Roots of Change

March 26, 2022 – July 24, 2022

The concept of change is the inspiration for all of the work in the show "Roots of Change." Within each humble seed, potential exists for something magnificent. As these seeds begin to sprout, hidden below the surface, change is taking place. Each seed sends out a complex system of roots that multiply, provide support, and nourish new life. In this way, seeds are much like ideas; from humble beginnings spectacular results can be achieved.

March 26, 2022 – May 21, 2022

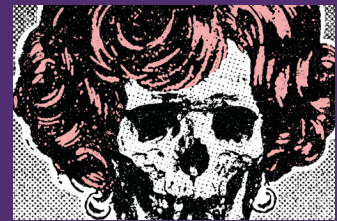
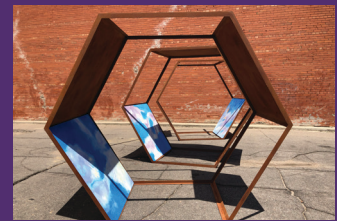
The Francis King Collection of Western Art was founded upon the generous donation of collector Francis E. King of Pueblo in 1979. The collection spans over one hundred-fifty years of Western history and represents a rich diversity of styles and subject matter. It begins with artist Joseph Hitchins in 1825, and includes such greats as Gerald Cassidy, John Clymer, Gerard C. Delano, Frank Tenney Johnson, William Moyers, O. C. Seltzer, and Harvey Otis Young.
