Sangre de Cristo Arts & Conference Center's 2022 Exhibition Bringing the Region to the Regional

August 12, 2022 will be an exciting day at the Sangre de Cristo Arts & Conference Center as we celebrate 50 years of culture and community through our event *Coming Home*. To coincide with this special event, the Helen Thatcher White Galleries will debut the eclectic exhibition *Bringing the Region to the Regional* in the first floor Regional Gallery. While the outdoor event will celebrate our history as a part of the Pueblo and greater southwestern community, the exhibit will be a celebration of art created by the people we support and are supported by.

We invite all artists and artisans who either work in the Southwest or are influenced by the southwest/southwestern culture to submit a piece for this juried exhibition. Submissions do not need to represent or depict the southwest/southwestern culture. We are open to all genres and media; however, **we are unable to accept audio or video submissions.**

Important Dates

July 29, 2022: Digital images, artist statement (200 words or less), entry fees due

July 30, 2022: Notification of acceptance will be via email or phone call

August 2-6, 2022: Artwork drop-off or delivery, completed inventory sheet, high-resolution images (see Rules), and signed contract for accepted works

August 12, 2022: First day of exhibition

November 26, 2022: Last day of exhibition

November 29-December 3, 2022: Artwork pickup or return, artists must call Guest Services at 719-295-7200 ahead of time.

Entry Rules

1. *Bringing the Region to the Regional* is open to all artists who work in or are influenced by the Southwest (Arkansas, Colorado, Louisiana, Montana, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Texas, Utah and Wyoming) or Southwestern culture. We are interested in original artwork. We require an artist's statement of 200 words or less explaining how your experience as an artist has been shaped by the southwest.

3. **All images MUST be submitted in digital form. Non-digital images will not be considered for acceptance into the exhibit.** We request high-resolution images with a resolution of at least 300 dpi, or greater, and as a .tiff or .jpg that can be reproduced at 1,650 pixels wide. Works must not have been previously shown at the Sangre de Cristo Arts & Conference Center.

4. Non-refundable entry fee of \$35 includes up to three (3) entries per artist.

5. Limit of three (3) entries per artist.

6. All wall-hung pieces must arrive prepared for hanging. **No saw-tooth hangers.** All works on paper must be framed under glass or plexiglass. 3D pieces must be stable and ready to display. All pieces must be clean and in good condition.

7. When indicating size please include frame size.

8. Artwork will NOT be sold at this exhibit, however professional artists are welcome to leave business cards which we will make available to the public.

Liability

Insurance is carried by the Sangre de Cristo Arts Center. Every responsible precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of your artwork. SdC will not insure artworks in transit. Entry to the Bringing the Region to the Regional exhibit will be considered acceptance of the waiver of liability. Artists will be responsible for transportation to and from the exhibition at their own expense and risk. SdC will not pay for shipping or make arrangements for shipping of accepted artworks. Return shipping must be paid or prepaid by the artist.

Payment of fees will be handled through the www.callforentry.org payment procedures, by check to Sangre de Cristo Arts Center ATTN: RTW, or by credit card, at the Welcome Center or by phone (719-295-7200).
